Covid-19 Update



On March 7th, China Customs announced the statistics on China Import & Export for the first two months in 2020. The total value of foreign trade in the first two months was US\$ 592 billion, 11% lower than that of 2019, of which export value was US\$ 292.5 billion, dropped by 17.2% and import value was US\$ 299.5 billion dropped by 4%.

The reason for the big drop in exports is obvious. It is mainly due to the impact of the Corona Virus, as well as the extended Chinese New Year Holidays.

By March 9th, all Shipco offices in China have become fully manned. The operations of warehouses, truckers (except those to/from Hubei province), and terminals also return to the normal schedule.

Same as the general situation of the recovery of the Chinese economy as well as the resume of import & export, most of the Shipco China offices are regaining our volume week by week.
